Lori Shutter, MD, FCCM, FNCS, FAAN, is a neuro-intensivist and Professor in the Departments of Critical Care Medicine, Neurology, and Neurosurgery at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine, where she serves as Vice Chair of Education, Director of the Multidisciplinary Critical Care and Neurocritical Care Fellowship Training Programs, and Division Chief of Neurocritical Care. Dr. Shutter's research focuses on traumatic brain injury and advanced neuro-monitoring, and she is active in development of clinical guidelines related to neurocritical care. She has published over 150 research papers, guidelines, and book chapters, and is one of the study Principal Investigators for the BOOST-3 trial. Her academic honors include the Leonard Tow Humanism in Medicine Award and Executive Leadership in Academic Medicine (ELAM) Fellowship.
