Diane L. Damiano, PhD, FAPTA is a tenured Senior Investigator at NIH and Chief of the Neurorehabilitation and Biomechanics Research Section in the Rehabilitation Medicine Department. Her research focuses on design and investigation of activity-based interventions and development of robotic devices to promote motor functioning and enhance muscle and neuroplasticity in CP. She has pioneered the use of mobile brain imaging to investigate cortical activation during motor skill acquisition in infants and children with/out CP. She is a past President of the American Academy for Cerebral Palsy and Developmental Medicine and the Gait and Clinical Movement Analysis Society.
